


Objective:

- 1. Read informational texts and discuss reasons the author gives to support his/her point.
- 2. Use writing & drawing to compose informational texts.
- 3. Explain how humans can change the environment.

Procedure:

- Encourage students to consider whether or not we need Earth Day and how celebrating this day helps us, as you read a book such as "Earth Day" by Trudi Strain Trueit or "It's Earth Day!" by Mercer Mayer.
- 2. Make a class book about making a difference on Earth Day.
- 3. Have students brainstorm problems and solutions.
- 4. Use the "Take Action" chart to help students plan each page of the class book.
