Opinion Writing Checklist:

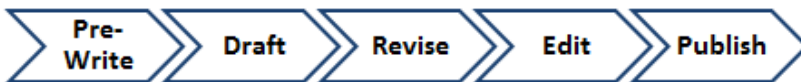
- My opening statement is engaging and clearly states my opinion.
- I organized my writing into paragraphs (introduction, body paragraphs, & conclusion).
- I provided reasons for my position and used specific examples from the text to make my point.
- I linked opinions and reasons using words, phrases and clauses (ex: specifically, consequently).
- My conclusion persuades the audience that the book I chose is the best *Coming of Age* novel.
- I have expanded, combined, & reduced sentences to make them more interesting to the reader.
- I have checked my writing to ensure correct use of the following:
 - Capitalization & End Punctuation
 - Correct Punctuation of Titles
 - Quotation Marks to Indicate Direct Quotes from Texts
 - Commas
