

CHORAL READING



Objectives:

- Read aloud with fluency.
- Read aloud with expression.
- Read aloud with accuracy.
- Read aloud with appropriate

Procedure:

- Display poem (project it) and introduce it to students.
 - Discuss what makes a poem different from other texts.
 - Read it aloud to the students.
 - Students should brainstorm questions they have after reading the poem.
 - Evaluate punctuation
 - Why did the poet use this particular punctuation?
 - How does this change the way we read the words?
- Allow students a chance to practice reading the poem together in partners or small groups..
- Choral read the poem aloud, as a whole class.
