Objectives:

- Read with purpose and understanding.
- Read with accuracy, appropriate rate, and expression.

Procedure:

- The teacher reads We The Kids by: David Catrow aloud and discuss as a class.
- Divide the class into 8 groups and have them practice choral reading the constitution.
- Assign a specific "chunk" of the preamble to each group.
- Read the preamble aloud, as a class with each group choral reading their specific chunk of the text.
- If possible, record the students as they read and then allow them to view and analyze their accuracy, rate, and expression.
