

# Steps For Implementing Cues, Questions, & Advance Organizers

1

Plan Purposeful Questions:

Pose questions that will help students focus on what's important. Remember to ask questions at every stage of the learning experience. Asking questions is an effective formative assessment as it allows the teacher to gauge student learning and determine if there are misunderstandings about a topic.

Ask Higher-Level Questions:



Asking questions that require students to analyze information, think critically, and synthesize information will prepare students for the real-world experiences.

Increase Wait Time:

Providing students with a few extra seconds to respond can greatly improve the quality of the responses and the amount of participation.



4

Tell Students Why:

Providing students with the big picture will increase their ability to see where the learning is headed and why it is important.



5

Address Learning Styles:

Presenting information visually (through graphic organizer), verbally, and in written form will increase learning for all students.
