

Your writing will be assessed using the Opinion Writing Rubric. Use the checklist below and the rubric to help you plan and edit your work.

Opinion Writing Checklist:

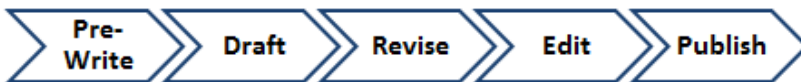
- Topic sentence clearly states my opinion.
