


Objectives:

- Ask and answer questions about key details in a text.
- Distinguish between information provided by the illustrations and information provided by the words.
- Use the illustrations and the text to describe key details.

Assignment Description

- 1. Introduce the book A Weed Is A Flower by Aliki. Explain that illustrations and text are both very important features of a book.
- 2. Guide students as they read by asking them what they can learn from just the illustrations. Students should record their responses on sticky notes that can later be added to a class chart (such as the one provided).
- 3. Next read the text aloud as students record information learned from the text on another sticky note.
- 4. Add information to the chart and discuss how good readers use the illustrations and the text for information.
