

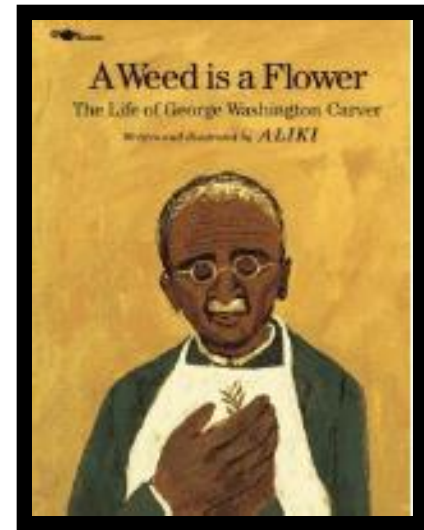
# YOU CAN LEARN A LOT FROM A PICTURE!

## Objectives:

- Ask and answer questions about key details in a text.
- Distinguish between information provided by the illustrations and information provided by the words.
- Use the illustrations and the text to describe key details.

## Assignment Description

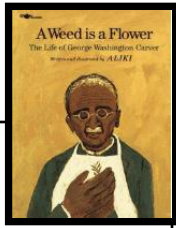
1. Introduce the book *A Weed Is A Flower* by Aliki. Explain that illustrations and text are both very important features of a book.
2. Guide students as they read by asking them what they can learn from just the illustrations. Students should record their responses on sticky notes that can later be added to a class chart (such as the one provided).
3. Next read the text aloud as students record information learned from the text on another sticky note.
4. Add information to the chart and discuss how good readers use the illustrations and the text for information.
