Read Aloud

In order to strengthen literacy skills of all students, teachers will do the following when reading aloud.

- Teacher will preview book:
 - Teacher will prompt students to describe the roll of the author & illustrator in terms of presenting ideas and information within the text.
 - Identify the Identify specific features of informational text (exfront cover, title, title page, back cover, headings, graphs, bold text, etc.).
 - Students will infer the type of text (informational).
- Teacher will prompt students to describe the relationship between illustrations and the text(ex: How does this picture help you better understand the topic?).
- Teacher will prompt students to use and explain strategies for dealing with unknown words in a story (ex: That's a really hard word. How can I figure out what that word means?).
- Teacher will encourage students to ask and answer questions about main idea & key details in the text.
- Teacher will prompt students to make connections between two individuals, events, ideas, and/or pieces of information in a text.
- Teacher will prompt students to identify the reasons an author gives to support points in a text.
- Teacher will encourage students to ask questions & discuss.
