Literature

Read Aloud

In order to strengthen literacy skills of all students, teachers will do the following when reading aloud.

- Teacher will preview book:
 - Identify title, author, & illustrator
 - Brief Picture Walk
 - Students will infer the type of literature (ex: Story, Poem)
- Teacher will prompt students to describe the relationship between illustrations and the story (ex: Why do you think the author included this picture?).
- Teacher will prompt students to use and explain strategies for dealing with unknown words in a story (ex: That's a really hard word. How can I figure out what that word means?)
- Teacher will encourage students to ask and answer questions about key details in the text.
- Teacher will prompt students to (orally) retell story.
- Teacher will prompt students to identify characters, setting, and major events (key details) of a story.
- Teacher will prompt students to compare and contrast the experiences of characters within a story.
- Teacher will encourage students to ask questions & discuss.
