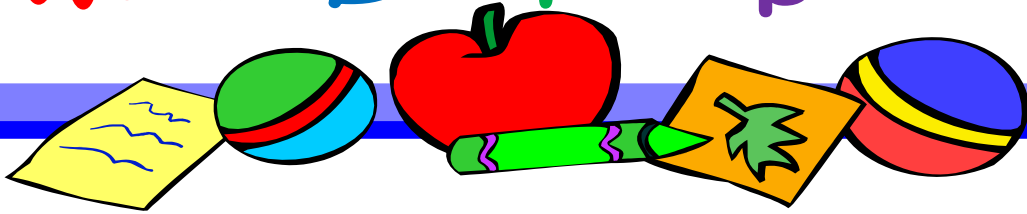


Kinder, Kinder

What Do You Sense?



1. After learning about the 5 senses, students will take turns asking classmates what they sense. (Ex: “Johnny, Johnny what do you touch?”)
2. Students will answer the question appropriately. (Ex: “Jenny, Jenny, I touch soft pillows.”)
3. Students should repeat the game until all students have a chance to respond to that particular question.
4. Continue until all 5 senses are addressed.

Literature Connection

1. Prior to completing this activity, read “Brown Bear, Brown Bear” by: Eric Carle with the class.
2. After completing “Kinder, Kinder What Do You Sense?” ask students how this activity was similar to the Eric Carle’s story.
3. Have students brainstorm other activities (or games) that mimic Carle’s pattern.
4. Allow students to try out their ideas.
