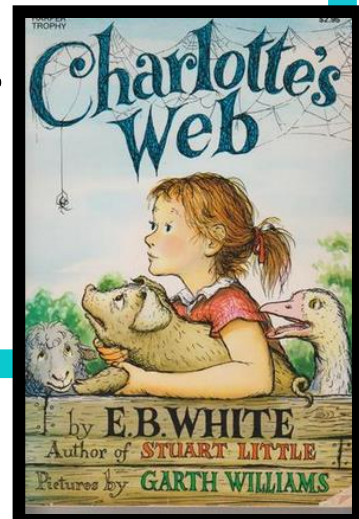

Within The Letter Explain:











- Why you choose the character
