Mini Lessons

Within Literature:

- 1. Select a passage showcasing dialogue from texts at students' reading level.
- 2. Ask students to highlight commas and quotation marks using 2 different colors (ex: red for commas / blue for quotation marks).
- 3. Discuss the way in which commas and quotation marks work to separate the speaking parts from the rest of the text..

Within Our Writing:

- Model writing dialogue for your students. Use 3 colors (Ex: red for Speaker 1, blue for Speaker 2, & black for all other text).
- 2. Make certain to connect the way we write back to the what the students observed in the literature they examined.
- 3. Allow students opportunities to practice writing dialogue (using multiple colors).
- 4. Ask students to check their writing for commas and quotation marks.
