

Metacognitive Conversations

Teaching students to talk about the way they arrive at ideas and think through complex tasks .

Bookmarks

Encourage students to use the bookmarks to help them actively participate in metacognitive conversations.

Questioning:

A question I have is...
I still wonder about...
Could this mean that...



Making Connections:

This reminds me of...
This is like...



Identifying A Problem:

I got confused when...
I'm not sure about...
I didn't expect...



Using Fix-Ups:

- I'll reread this part
- I'll ignore this part for now, but I'll come back to it later
- I'll ask someone about this...
- I can relate to this text because...



Summarizing:

The big idea is...
I think the point is...
So what it's saying is...

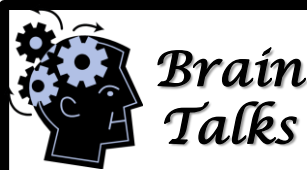
